Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 14/07/2020.

I note you seek access to the following information:

How many times between 1.1.2019 and 31.12.2019(inclusive) and 1.1.2020 and 10.7.2020 has your force arrested either the son or daughter of a serving police officer who serves with your force? Who was then charged with a criminal offence or given a police caution? How many offences in each the categories below were charged or caution issued:

Arson and criminal damage

Burglary

Drug offences

Historical fraud and Forgery

Miscellaneous crimes against and society

Possession of weapons

Public Order offences

Robbery

Sexual offences

Theft

Vehicle offences

Violence against the person

OR

How many police officers who are serving with your force have you been made aware, that either their son or daughter has been arrested by your force and is waiting to appear in court

NB Son or daughter is to be taken to mean biological parents, adoptive parents, foster parents or for any person they are acting in loco parentis.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police have not been made aware of any instances where the Son or Daughter of a serving Leicestershire Police Officer has been arrested by Leicestershire Police in the time period requested.

This information is reliant on Leicestershire Police being notified by the appropriate source, i.e. a Notifiable Association Declaration from the Officer who is the parent, or a referral from the Officer in Case, if they were made aware of a familial link.

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
