Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 27/07/2020.

I note you seek access to the following information:

Could you please disclose how many people were charged with driving offences involving drinks and/or drugs, and failing to give a specimen in Leicester between 1 July 2019, and 30 June 2020?

Could you please disclose line by line how many people were fined due to or charged with speeding offences in Leicester and what speed they were driving at when they got caught between 1 July 2019, and 30 June 2020?

Could you please disclose how many people were fined due to or charged with "driving using a mobile phone" in Leicester between 1 July 2019, and 30 June 2020?

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Please see attached spreadsheet detailing charges issued in relation to drug / drink driving offences in the time period requested.

No charges were made for speeding or mobile phone offences in the time period. However we have detailed below the number of these offences recorded in the time period:

Speeding Offences

39392 fixed penalty notices were issued for speeding in the time period.

We do not give out specific speeds, however we can confirm the numbers of notices were within the below thresholds:

Speed awareness course threshold – 34700

Conditional Offer threshold– 3881

Court threshold – 785

Speed not recorded on system – 26

Mobile phone offences

297 fixed penalty notices were issued for driving whilst using a mobile phone in the time period

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
