### **Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I write further to your request for information received 14/08/2020.

I note you seek access to the following information:

*The Office of Dr Luke Evans MP has been contacted by constituent David Quinney of Roston Drive in Hinckley, with concerns about speeding traffic on Roston Drive.*

*Mr Quinney tells us that "I have been complaining about this for at least 20 years but no-one seems interested. Several years ago speed readings were taken when several were recorded in excess of 80mph. I have complained to the local police but again, no action has been taken."*

*Could you advise me if there have been any recent monitoring events on Roston Drive and a brief summary of their findings, plus a summary of recorded accidents and complaints of speeding please?*

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

### **Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -**

Please see data below for speeding notices. Roston Drive was a former 'Community Concern' site for the camera vans but has not been since 2015. There are no records of any complaint in the Road Safety Unit since then.
