This is a request for information about the number of active police stations which fall under the force's remit, and the number that have closed in the last decade.

Please could you provide the number of active police stations, along with the address of each?

Could you also provide the number of police stations that have closed over the last ten years?

Could these be broken down by the month they closed, and if possible could the address be provided too?

By 'active,' I mean a facility with a physical public facing counter.
