I write further to your request for information received 09/02/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

This is a request for information about the revenue made from selling police stations over the last ten years.

Could you please provide details from the sale of each police station sold over the last ten years, including the date the building was sold, the sale price and the address of the property.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police have sold the below properties in the last 10 years, most of which have been replaced by alternative properties:

- Ashby Neighbourhood Office LE65 5BS - Sold in 2012 - £265K - No FEO - replaced by rooms in the local leisure centre.
- Belgrave Police Station LE47AN - Sold in 2014 - £410K - No FEO - replaced by rooms in the local council community centre.
- Blaby Police Station LE83GQ - Sold in 2011, £335K.
- Bottesford Police Station NG13 0AH - Sold in 2012 - £240K - No FEO - replaced by space at local secondary school.
- Coalville Police Station LE672QS - Sold in 2019 - £675K - FEO replaced in local council offices - new station in partnership building with fire and ambulance.
- Hinckley Police Station LE101RH - Sold in 2012 - £360K - FEO and station moved to new building next door.
- Hinckley Road Police Station LE3 0TD - Sold in 2018 - £850K - FEO and station moved to new building next door.

- Lutterworth Police Station LE174DY - Sold in 2015 - £232K - No FEO, relocated to local leisure centre.
- Market Bosworth CV13 0LA - Sold in 2014 - £325 - No FEO - retained smaller part of the building.
- Quorn Neighbourhood Office LE12 8ES - Sold in 2012 - £312K - No FEO - relocated to local secondary school.
- Rutland Police Station LE156QX - Sold in 2015 - £675K - FEO moved to local council offices, retained some land and replaced old station with a new smaller building.
- Syston Police Station LE72EN - Sold in 2015 - £350K - relocated to council offices.
- Uppingham Station LE5 3TA - Sold in 2011 - £180K - No FEO, relocated to town council building.
- Welford Road Police Station LE47AD - Sold in 2016 - £525K.

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
