I write further to your request for information received 15/02/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

For children that had missing episodes recorded in your missing persons database (or equivalent central recording system), and had been flagged as being at risk of child sexual exploitation, please provide a breakdown of their ages. Please provide their age at the time of the first missing episode recorded, if simplest to extract.

Please limit this request to missing episodes between 1st January 2020 and today's date, and to children who went missing at least three times over the period. If your systems flag episodes rather than children as being a CSE risk, please provide information for children who had at least one CSE risk flagged episode during this period.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police can confirm we have recorded the below in relation to your request:

In the period of 1 January 2020 to 9 March 2021 there were 1003 individual children who were subject of a missing report.

214 of those children were reported missing more than twice.

105 of those children were recorded on police occurrences that were marked as "Child Sexual Abuse with Sexual Exploitation".

55 of those children appeared on the occurrence as an aggrieved party and 50 were recorded with another connection.

Of the 55 who appeared as an aggrieved person, the ages break down as follows:
