Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 23/02/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

Q1. Between 23/03/2019 and 22/02/2020 how many of the following did your force record:

a. PS10.

b. PS10 with Mental Health qualifier.

c. PS10 with Suicide or Suicide risk qualifier.

Q2. Exactly the same info as Q.1 a, b and c above, but for the time period 23/03/2020 to 22/02/2021.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police do not hold the information in the manner which you have requested.

Leicestershire Police are able to provide the number of 'Concern for Safety Incidents' however this does cover a multitude of circumstances, the number of these recorded in the time periods specified are:

Concern for Safety

23/03/2020 to 22/02/2021	38750

Leicestershire Police are also able to provide mental health incidents, that is, those with a specific mental health identifier, however we do not have a suicide or suicide risk identifier, the number of these recorded in the time periods specified are:

23/03/2020 to 22/02/2021	9962
