Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 23/03/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

In the 2020 calendar year how many juveniles (children aged 10-17 inclusive) did you arrest who had already been arrested at least 49 previous times by your force in their past?

For each individual please state (i) the total number of times they have been arrested by your force, (ii) their age when first arrested, (iii) their age when last arrested and (iv) a breakdown of the offences for which they were arrested.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -
