I write further to your request for information received 23/03/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

Please can you tell me how many formal complaints female Met officers have made regarding sexual discrimination or sexual harassment at work over the last three years (to the present day)?

For each complaint, please can you give me:

- a) details about / a description of the complaint*
- b) the outcome of the complaint*

If you can also give the following info, please do, but if this will take you over the cost threshold or involve personal information, please leave it out:

- c) the current employment status of the officer(s) being complained about including if they are suspended*
- d) the current employment status of the complainant*

Amendment to original request

Further to my request, I apologise for my mistake where I requested for complaints made by female Met officers and staff. I meant complaints made by female officers and staff employed by your force, against officers and staff employed by your force.

I also meant the three years 23 March 2018 to 23 March 2021.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police has one case: within the times specified in your request-

Allegation of inappropriate and derogatory gender orientated comments and behaviour within a Police Station.

No officer was identified as being the subject of the allegation and no further action was taken.

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
