I write further to your request for information received 21/04/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

would you be so kind to please tell me on how many occasions, since 1st of January 2020 (to the current day), officers/staff were recorded as having not switched on their BWV devices for an incident which required them to do so under your force's policy. Please can you tell me how many "complaints" from members of the public regarding BWV were received over that period and how many of these were subsequently upheld.

By "complaints" regarding BWV devices, I am seeking information relating to complaints by members of the public (including third parties who were not subject to the interaction) who have complained the use of the body-worn video cameras violated their privacy. I am also seeking information relating to complaints from people who claimed that the responding officer's BWV devices were not turned on for the interaction (when they should have been). In your response, could you please distinguish between the two different types of complaints.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police do not hold any data that fits the criteria in your request in relation to BWV

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
