I write further to your request for information received 29/04/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

- 1) How many crimes of theft from a vehicle, classed as 'van' or 'light commercial vehicle', where 'tools', 'tool', 'tools power' or 'tools sundry' were recorded as stolen has there been since (2017-2021) broken down by month?*
- 2) How many crimes of theft from a construction site, where 'tools', 'tool', 'tools power' or 'tools sundry' were recorded as stolen has there been since (2017-2021) broken down by month?*
- 3) How many crimes of theft from a commercial property, where 'tools', 'tool', 'tools power' or 'tools sundry' were recorded as stolen has there been since (2017-2021) broken down by month?*
- 4) How many of these cases resulted in a police charge?*
- 5) How many of these cases resulted in tools being 'recovered' or 'returned to owner'?*
- 6) What was the total monetary value of tools stolen per reported case?*
- 7) What was the profession / job title / industry of the person who reported a tool theft incident from a van, commercial vehicle and on-site / property?*
- 8) What type of tool was reported as stolen across each case logged from 2017-2021*
- 9) Can you provide the day of the week the case was reported for each crime from 2017 - 2021?*
- 10) Please can you provide the town names where each tool theft case was reported from 2017-2021?*

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Please find attached spreadsheet containing information relating to your request.

Please note we are unable to provide the monetary value of stolen goods as this not recorded as a matter of course. This information may have been provided on occasion, however it would require a manual review of each records working sheets to identify whether any have the information recorded, this would invoke section 12.

Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address.
