Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 01/06/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

A breakdown of the figures of the total number of domestic violence reports to your Police Force between 1st April 2020 and 31st March 2021

Please break down the figures into gender (male and female) as follows:

1. *Named suspect identified: Evidential difficulties prevent further action, victim does not support (or has withdrawn from) police action*
2. *Named suspect identified, victim supports police action but evidential difficulties prevent further action*
3. *Charge or summons*
4. *Investigation complete: No suspect identified. Crime investigated as far as reasonably possible - Case closed pending further investigative opportunities becoming available*
5. *Charge/ Summons for alternative offence*
6. *Named suspect not identified, the crime is confirmed by the victim either declines or is unable to support further police investigation to identify offender*
7. *Postal charge*
8. *Caution adult including conditional caution*
9. *Other agency takes primacy*
10. *Community resolution*
11. *Postal charge with alternative offence*
12. *Adult caution with alternative offence*
13. *Sufficient evidence to charge, but police decided not in the public interest to prosecute*
14. *Suspect identified but prosecution time limit expired - 5 years ago*
15. *Named suspect identified, but police decide investigation not in the public interest*
16. *Non crime*
17. *Prosecution prevented, named suspect identified but is too ill (physical or mental health) to prosecute*
18. *The offender has died*
19. *Charge*
20. *Youth caution with alternative offence*
