Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write further to your request for information received 15/06/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

- *Number of warnings issued under section 59 of the Police Reform Act 2002 for the antisocial use of a vehicle. In addition, number of warnings issued to riders of an e-scooter.*
- *Number of vehicles seized under section 59 of the Police Reform Act 2002. In addition, the number of e-scooters seized using this power.*
- *I would like all of this data for 2018/19, 2019/20 and 2020/21 financial years please.*

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Number of warnings issued is as follows:

2018 191
2019 198
2020 254
2021 191

Below are the figures for the number of seizures under Sec 59 PRA 2002, for all vehicles, they are:

2018-19	16
2019-20	25
2020-21	20

None of these are e-scooters as the legislation used to seize them is different, namely Section 165 Road Traffic Act 1988 which does not require a warning before seizure or that the rider is committing an offence of careless driving or riding on land without permission before it can be used.

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
