I write further to your request for information received 24/06/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

Could you please provide me with the number of Fixed Penalty Notices issued for cycling offences, grouped by category (ag riding though a red light, cycling on the pavement) for 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021.

Could you also tell me what the financial penalty is for a Fixed Penalty Notice for each of those years?

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

The table below details the cycling fixed penalties issued.

All penalties were £50.00 except

Use on a road a pedal cycle when the front / rear lamps / retro reflectors were not clean / in good working order

For which a rectification notice was issued.
