2. Leicestershire Police's total annual spend on these areas is:

Electrical - £300,000
Building Work - £1,440,000
Roofing - £30,000
3. The framework covers reactive maintenance and planned maintenance for:

Plumbing and Heating – including: water and gas, from repairs and maintenance to refurbishment projects.
Surfacing works – includes: resurfacing paths and roads.
Electrical Works – Including bulb changes to new fittings.
Roofing Services – Including: flat roofs, pitched tiles, from repairs and maintenance to replacement roofing projects.
General Building – including: joinery, minor repairs and planned projects.

The framework also covers painting & drainage.
4. Leicestershire Police have 31 buildings over 20 sites which this framework covers.
5. The framework start date was 1st April 2017.
6. The framework expires 31st March 2022.
7. The duration of the framework is 5 years.
8. Leicestershire Police are looking to publish the opportunity for a new framework in September.
