I write further to your request for information received 08/07/2021.

I note you seek access to the following information:

I would like a detailed response identifying the revenue received from The Removal, Storage and Disposal of Vehicles (Prescribed Sums and Charges) Regulations 2008, in the last 5 years.

In particular we would like answers to the following:

What income does the force received as a result of its activities involving the removal, storage and disposal of vehicles either directly or from referral or management fees? What proportion of that revenue a) goes to HM Treasury, b) is retained by the Police Authority, c) goes to a Management Agent(s), and d) goes to Recovery Operator Agent(s)

We would like answers to each question above listed per annum and per month and per region if possible, across the last 5 years.

I would prefer to receive any information in an electronic format.

If it is not possible to provide the information requested due to the information exceeding the cost of compliance limits identified in Section 12, please provide advice and assistance, under the Section 16 obligations of the Act, as to how I can refine my request.

If you can identify any ways that my request could be refined I would be grateful for any further advice and assistance.
