How many reports of alleged criminal activity have you received linked to The Samaritans charity or any of its local branches, involving staff or volunteers, between 2017 and 2021?

Please break this information down by date and by nature of the allegation, including as much detail as is available.

Please present each incident in the following format:

Date of report

Date of alleged incident

Nature of alleged incident (including as much detail as you hold)

Action taken, if any

Please send this information in Excel format.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within Leicestershire Police to locate information relevant to your request.

Your request for information has now been considered and the information asked for is as follows: -

Leicestershire Police have searched the appropriate systems, whilst there are 5 offences in which the text 'Samaritans' appears, NONE (zero) of these involve the Samaritans in the offence. Most are where the aggrieved initially report 'to' the Samaritans who then notified us.

Therefore, no information is held that is specific to your request.

At this time, I am unable to suggest how you can define your request for us to provide useful information for you
