Leicestershire Police Business Objects Universe does not hold details of "Convictions", we can only provide details of where a person was Charged to appear in Court, if you require details of Convictions you will need to apply to HM Courts Service.

Q5 is not possible as our crime recording system (Niche) does not have a field to record the Sexual Orientation of the people involved.

You have asked for "incidents and crimes" (which I have provided) but only Crimes can result in a person being Charged.

Leicestershire Police provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure. Letters should be addressed to Information Manager, Corporate Services Department at the above address. If you decide to request such a review and having followed the Force's full process you are still dissatisfied, then you have the right to direct your comments to the Information Commissioner who will give it consideration.
