

NHCAW Pledge Photo How To Guide

As part of this year's National Hate Crime Awareness Week (NHCAW) we are asking the communities of Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland to pledge their support.

A pledge board has been designed for pledges to be typed onto then sent over to us via email or Twitter.

The template is a Word document with a specific text box for the pledge to be typed into and a box for an image too.

Here is how to do it:

It looks like this:

Insert photo

 Name – Role, Organisation (delete if not applicable)

Click onto or highlight where it says 'type your pledge here' and type your pledge.

Do the same with and 'add your name, role and organisation' along the bottom of the page (or delete if not applicable).

There is an option within the pledge box to include a picture of yourself (although it is not compulsory).

Choose the photo you would like to include and go to **insert, select picture** and navigate to where your picture is saved. Click onto the picture and it will appear on your pledge board, you may have to move the image using the boxes that appear at the corners of the image.

Then save the pledge by selecting **file** then **save as** ready to send over to us.

If you would prefer not to include an image simply delete the grey box and the insert photo wording.

Another way of sending us an image is to take a selfie with your pledge. If you have printed it you can hold it up so it is visible when you take your selfie or if the pledge is on a laptop or tablet screen have the screen facing forward so both you and the pledge are visible in your photo.

Once it is complete it's time to send your pledge over to us, there are two of ways to do this. You can Tweet it via @LPStaySafe or email it to NHCAWLeics@leicestershire.pnn.police.uk
